This 5 day experiential Sandtray-Worldplay Training Intensive, for Commuters and for Residents, is offered 25 miles from downtown Atlanta and 35 miles from the Atlanta airport in the calm and comfort of the 227-acre wooded Simpsonwood Conference - Retreat Center, alongside the Chattahoochee River, where Gisela held her first transformational retreat in Atlanta November 2007. The environment, the grounds and the staff are most supportive for creating a sacred learning and journey environment. For your convenience, you may commute to Simpsonwood or stay overnight at the Lodge. To deepen our sense of community, we will have our lodging rooms in the same small building, nestled amidst the trees, where our playroom is located.

As Commuter you pay tuition for the course plus a day-use fee (\$32 per day incl. tax), which provides use of the beautiful grounds, trails, the labyrinth, lunch and 2 nutritious snacks, shopping with Images of the Mandala and Vision Quest Images, use of the Sandtray-Worldplay Room from 8am till 9pm.

As Lodger first register, pay tuition, and the 1 day-use fee (if you do not lodge the night before your first training day). **Then book your lodging directly with Simpsonwood at 770-441-1111 or 800-238-8685**: single (\$129 w.tax) and double \$95.50) rooms are available. Provide Simpsonwood with the name of your room mate at the time of registration. Partners are welcome and may join us during communal meals but not in the play room. Check-in Time is 4pm and check-out time is 10am. Otherwise your Room Reservation provides you with Breakfast, Lunch and dinner. On the day you check out, you receive breakfast and lunch. Level One Sandtray-Worldplay Workshop Goals and Objectives:

Day 1 Learning Objectives (on this day we cover Level One, Part 3) Participants:

The Morning 8:30-12:30pm

1. Review how to set-up the indoor and outdoor Sandtray-Worldplay Space
2. Understand the Playroom Set-Up for elemental and nature play
3. Record elemental play: identify the relevancy of the human experiences depicted in their own, their partner's, children's and adult's sandplay

The Afternoon 1:30-5:30pm

4. Continue to experience, witness, facilitate, understand the relevancy of elemental, primordial Sandtray-Worldplay Therapy for human growth and development
5. Engage in discussion and problem solving about the therapeutic and developmental value of specific elemental and nature play scenarios
6. Journal their own elemental play experience and link it to their current personal and professional life-challenges
7. Experience or witness a joint Sandtray-Worldplay

Day 2 Learning Objectives (we cover Level 1, Prt3 and portions of Prt2 cont):

The Morning 8:30-12:30

1. Cite the therapeutic basis of each phase of the Sandtray-Worldplay session and when to use them with pre-school children
2. Explore pre-school developmental play patterns
3. Know how to set-up the sandtray/sandplay space for pre-school children
4. Know how to support pre-school children's sandplay process
5. Know about the relationship between Capacity, Experience, Consciousness, and Language
6. Identify several pre-school developmental sandplay patterns when working with children and adults

The Afternoon 1:30-5:30pm

7. Participants continue to explore pre-school developmental play patterns
8. Experience, witness, and enact different pre-school developmental play patterns with a witness
9. Know about how to conduct sandplay sessions with the pre-schooler and his or her caretaker (s)
10. Translate the typical pre-school sandplay into therapeutic and educational goals
11. Journal their own and their partner's pre-school play

3. The different therapist-client interactions during the Sandtray-Worldplay session
4. The demonstrated Sandtray-Worldplay Session
5. How to use/not use verbal language

The Afternoon 1:30-5:30pm

6. About the role of Human consciousness, awakening perception, practicing presence, clusters, and meaning-making
7. Record the building of a Sandtray-World
8. Witness and record a demonstrated Sandtray-Worldplay session
9. Explore and process their own Sandtray-Worldplay while witnessed
10. Supervision, discussion and problem solving groups

Day 4 Learning objectives (we cover Level 1, Prt 2 and Part 1); Participants know:**The Morning 8:30-12:30**

1. About the different sandtray play styles of children
2. About the different types of Sandplay Worlds
3. How to observe, “map” and photograph the World
4. About ‘prepositional vocabulary’

The Afternoon 1:30-5:30pm

5. The nature of ‘symbolic interpretation’ and ‘authentic meaning making’
6. How to create their own World and how to “language” the various relationships in their own World
7. How to deepen the experience of the World-in-sand during the joint experiencing phase
8. How to come out of the World and end the session

Day 5: Learning Objectives (we cover Level 1, Prt 1) Participants know about:**The Morning 8:30-12:30**

1. Guidelines for creating a sandtray room for children
2. Basic history of play and sandtray/sandplay/Sandtray-Worldplay
3. Theoretical and therapeutic principles of Sandtray-Worldplay Therapy
4. How to introduce sandtray to parents, children, educators, in different settings
5. Witness demonstrations of specific interventions during the Sandtray-Worldplay Session

The Afternoon 1:30-5:30pm

6. Creating their own Sandtray-Worldplay while witnessed
7. Supporting the builder’s self experience without interpreting play content
8. Identify and work with the ‘growing edge’ of their own play and their partner’s play
9. Clinical case studies
10. Engage in discussion and problem solving to prepare working with pre-school children and the pre-school developmental tasks with ANY population
